
Collaborative Clinical Pathways – Map of Medicine transition instructions

Map of Medicine Pathways (Hearst UK) will no longer be available from the end of June 2018.

From 1 July 2018 local MidCentral Pathways (previously hosted on the Map of Medicine UK site) will be accessed through a New Zealand instance hosted by Waikato DHB. The website address is:

The New Zealand instance will display the Pathways in the same way experienced through Map of Medicine, however only local MidCentral pathways and other New Zealand pathways will be available. You will no longer be able to access pathways through Medtech. You can save the above link to your internet favourites or save to your desktop.
